Do your homework before applying.

- Write a customised cover letter to demonstrate your skills and personal brand, as well as the employer's core values, to impress recruiters

Verify that your references are current and contactable.

- Get in touch with potential references to confirm contact information and let them know they may be contacted.

Pay attention to your grammar and spelling.

- Take your time when creating an online profile, updating a resume, or writing a cover letter, and double-check your content before submitting.

Send an email of gratitude.

- Send a thank-you email after an interview to show appreciation and support the hiring manager's decision.
